## ACADEMIC POLICIES

- **Attendance:** Students should maintain an attendance of 75% in all subjects in order to be eligible to attend examinations. Below 60% even in a subject will be ineligible to attend examinations.
- **Internal Assessment:**
  - Theory - 03 (Avg of 03): Test =20 marks + Assignment/Activity =05 marks = Total 25 marks.
  - Practical - 02(Avg of 02): Test= 10 marks + Record= 10 marks+ Activity=05 marks = Total 25 marks

## CODE OF CONDUCT

- Attendance and Regularity: Students are required to attend classes regularly and punctually.
- Dress Code: All students must be formally dressed in uniform whenever they are in the college premises. On Wednesday, students are allowed to wear decent color dress. (Boys are not permitted to wear shorts, half pants. Girls are not permitted to wear T-Shirts and tight jeans).
